Night Positioning System





IMPORTANT

These instructions provide important information for the safe use and maintenance of the Night Positioning System. Please take the time to read the below; product must be used in accordance with the instructions to avoid any harm to the user.

Intended use

This product is designed to provide support and safety during lying or sitting for individuals who may have difficulty controlling their body parts, sitting upright or maintaining balance. This product is for indoor use. Assembly should only be performed by adults.

Package Contents

This product is completely assembled, you will only need to position the mattress and all the accessories you chose appropriately before use. Please check that you have all the accessories you ordered and then adjust the selected accessories.

Disposal

When a product reaches the end of its lifetime, it should be separated by material type so that the parts can be recycled and disposed of safely.

Maintenance

This product should be inspected, maintained, cleaned and/or washed routinely. Discontinue the use of this product if it becomes damaged, broken or disassembled. Contact your supplier for qualified repair or replacement. Do not alter or repair by unqualified people. In the case that modifications or repairs are made without having received written permission from the vendor, the warranty will be void.

SET UP

Mattress Standard Mode (Figure 1)

- Step 1 Open the storage bag, and take all the accessories and mattress out.
- **Step 2 -** Take off the straps and release the buckle on the mattress, and then put the mattress on a flat surface.
- **Step 3 -** Put all the pillows on the mattress and adjust the position according to the user's personal condition and preference. Attach the side with Velcro to the mattress of the Night Positioning System, ensuring that the pillow is securely fixed and won't shift.

Mattress Sitting Mode (Figure 2)

- **Step 1 -** Open the storage bag, and take all the accessories and mattress out.
- **Step 2 -** On the back of the mattress (full black side), there is a long webbing with a hook end. Insert the hook end into the insertion end on the short side of the mattress to buckle up. And then turn one end of the webbing back through the tri-glide slide on the webbing to tighten. Adjust the length of webbing to change the mattress's tilt angle.
- **Step 3 -** Put all the pillows on the mattress and adjust the position according to the user's personal condition and preference.

Fleece Sheet - if needed (Figure 3)


- **Step 1 -** Place the cover over the mattress and securely tighten the closing cord.
- **Step 2 -** Put all the pillows on the Fleece Sheet and adjust the position according to the user's personal condition and preference. Attach the side with Velcro to the Fleece Sheet , ensuring that the pillow is securely fixed and won't shift.

Belt Attachment - if needed (Figure 4)

Attach the belts using the loops on both sides of the mattress.

FOLD & STORE







Thread the upper and lower webbings through the loops on both sides.



Place the storage bag on the mattress and zip one side up. Note the handle should be facing the open side.

Put all the accessories into the bag and zip it up.

CLEANING

Please check the fabric label before washing.

BASE MATTRESS	 Wipe clean with a damp cloth and mild detergents. Do not use bleach or biological cleaners. Antibacterial spray or wipes can be used. If disinfection is necessary, clean with a solution of disinfectant with a damp cloth. 			
COVERS	Including mattress cover, fleece sheet, storage bag and all the pillow covers. • Fasten the zipper on the cover before washing. • Place the cover inside a laundry bag to prevent damage to it or washing machine/dryer. • Machine wash at 40°C or less with a mild detergent. • Lay mattress cover flat to dry in the shade. • Do not bleach or iron. • Do not dry clean. • NEVER use the mattress cover alone without base mattress installed.			
PILLOW INNER	 Wipe clean with a damp cloth and mild detergents. Do not use bleach or biological cleaners. 			
BELTS	 Minor spills can be removed with a damp cloth. Spillages should be removed as quickly as possible. Dab the stain, do not rub. Do not over wet the stain. Do not use organic solvents, dry cleaning fluids, abrasive cleaners or industrial bleaches. Antibacterial spray or wipes can be used. If disinfection is necessary, clean with a solution of disinfectant with a damp cloth. 			

Always ensure that the products are dry before use.

- Damage due to repairs carried out by unauthorized persons or due to improper disassembly of the product.
- Customer dissatisfaction with the product in terms of fit, weight, functionality, colour or design.

WARNING

- To avoid ensure that the user is kept away when unfolding and folding this product.
- To avoid serious injury from falling or sliding on the mattress, the user must always use the appropriate accessories. When securing the user with belts, ensure there is a finger's width between belt and user to prevent over tightening or user moving to an inappropriate position. And make sure the belt is long enough for the user.
- Do not use the Night Positioning System if any part is broken, torn or missing. The damaged or worn parts must be repaired immediately.
- This product has not been tested in conjunction with other manufacturer's products. Do not add any accessories other than Synetik Group approved accessories to this product.
- Any changes or alterations carried out by persons other than a Synetik Group authorised service person will invalidate the warranty and Synetik Group can accept no liability for any injury or damage so caused.
- Any serious incident that has occurred in relation to the products should be reported to the vendor and the competent authority of the region where the user is established.
